

Required Health Forms

This letter contains information about required health documentation for your child. New York State Education Law requires each new student to provide proof of required immunizations within 14 days of their entrance into school, 30 days if from out-of-state with proof of a physical examination. The law also requires school districts to request dental health certificates.

Enclosed in this packet is a Health Examination Form, a Student Health Information Form, a Medical Authorization Form, a Health Disclosure Form, a Dental Health Form, and an OTC Medication Letter.

Health Examination Form

- This form is to be completed by your child's physician or you may obtain a physician's form. Include an updated physical and immunizations.

Student Health Information form

- This form is to be completed by you, the parent.
- This form provides us with more specific information than the health appraisal form to assist us in providing a healthy and safe environment for your child.

Health Disclosure Form

- This form is signed by the parent, which would authorize the Brighton Central School District to exchange health information with your child's physician if necessary.

Dental Health Certificate

- This form is to be completed by your dentist/optional for parents to complete.

OTC Medication Letter

- NYS requires a Physicians signature for School Nurses to administer any over the counter medication.

Please return the completed forms to your child's school health office at the time of your school appointment. For further information, please feel free to call your school nurse.
