

Accessing a Zoom Class Meeting Using an iOS Device (iPad or iPhone)

Most often, your teacher will provide you with a link that you can simply click to enter the meeting.

Meeting Link: <https://zoom.us/j/1234567890?pwd=a2U5Sy8vSmVBSUZPV3c4YjFjFUGdWQT09>

If that clickable link does not work, or your teacher has sent you the Meeting ID and Password in an email then the process below will help you access your class Zoom meetings.

Meeting ID: 123 456 7890

Password: BCSD

Step 1

From your iOS device Home Page, locate the Zoom App icon

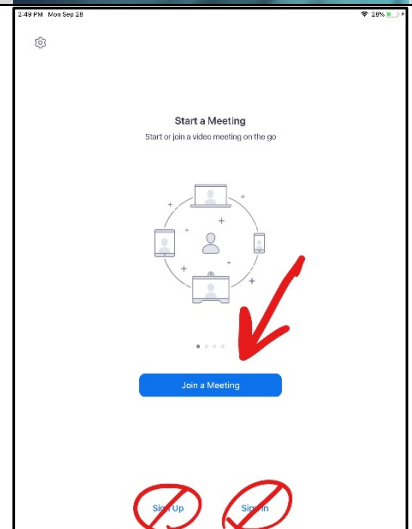


and tap it once. On some devices the icon will appear in the tray at the bottom of each page. On other devices, you may need to scroll through the app pages to locate the icon.



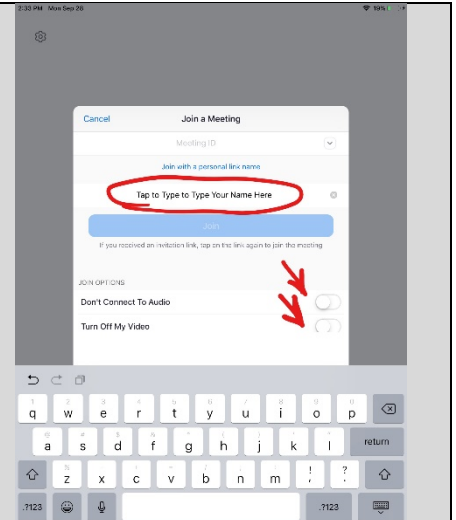
Step 2

Click on the Join Meeting button. There is no need for students to either create a Zoom account or to sign in to Zoom to attend a meeting hosted by a teacher.



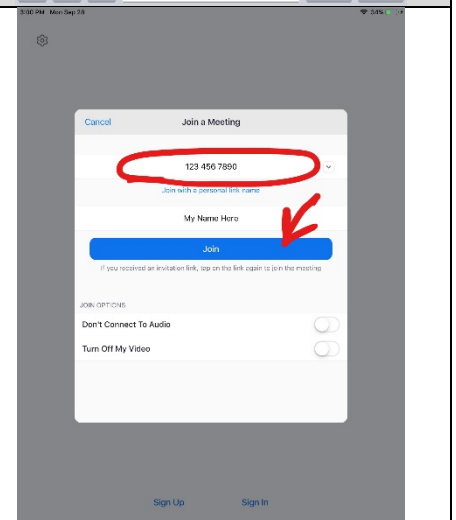
Step 3

When the Join Meeting screen pops up the default name will be your device name. Tap on the device name and enter your own name for the meeting. First name, last initial will work well to let your teacher know it is you. Leave the two toggles for video and audio unclicked.



Step 4

Enter the 10-digit meeting ID provided by your teacher in the appropriate box and click on the Join button to enter the meeting.



Step 5

If you are prompted for a meeting password, enter that in the pop-up box and click continue. At this point you will be either admitted automatically to the meeting or you will be placed in a waiting room. Your teacher will let you in when the class meeting starts.

If this process does not work to enter the meeting, please contact your teacher directly for guidance.
