## **Student Computer Acceptable Use Policy**

### **Council Rock Primary School Brighton Central School District**

Dear Parent/Guardian:

As you may know, the Brighton Central School District offers students a variety of resources over its computer network. Our network includes educational programs (raz kids, pbskids.com etc.), productivity applications (such as word processing), and presentation and drawing (kid pix).

The internet allows students the opportunity to reach out to many sources of information that would not otherwise be accessible to them. With your permission, your child will have supervised access to a wealth of information, enrichment, and remediation activities, as well as libraries and databases from all over the world.

With this educational opportunity also comes responsibility. The District has and will continue to provide education about internet safety through the classroom teacher. Adults are present during student internet use and know the purpose of its use, but may not be able to supervise all browsing at all times. Our internet instruction provides the students with excellent research strategies and guidance to safe sites, while offering the best supervision possible.

Please read the student agreement document, on the reverse side, with your child(ren) and discuss the requirements together. This AUP (Acceptable Use Policy) has been modified to provide more clear guidance to students about what is and is not appropriate use of the network.

**Upon entering a new building, (CRPS, FRES, TCMS, BHS) students will be required to sign and submit this form in order to use the computer resources available in each building. For your student to have independent access to the internet with supervision, you must complete the parent section of this form, and your child(ren) must sign the student agreement.**

**Please sign and return the student agreement, so that your child(ren) are not inconvenienced by a delay in the classroom use of software and internet.**
