Homecoming is a very festive and exciting occasion for teens, their friends, family members, and the Brighton community. Every effort has been made by the Executive Class Council, class officers, parent representatives, coaches, class advisors, the Brighton Chamber of Commerce, the Brighton Police Department, and administrators to plan an enjoyable week of events.

In order to help make our homecoming activities safe and welcoming for all involved, we encourage you to talk to your child about the week of events. Our events start with a **Homecoming Pep Rally** on Thursday night followed by the **Parade, Football Game and Homecoming Dance** Saturday. Please make sure that your child is aware of the following:

- 1. NO backpacks/bags are allowed in the stadium at the Homecoming Football Game.**
- 2. If there is reasonable suspicion that a student is under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, and therefore, in breach of school policy and code of conduct, students will be subjected to an assessment by Brighton staff, which may include an alco-sensor test, and parents will be contacted. Medical and/or law enforcement personnel may also be contacted for further involvement, assessment, and/or treatment.**
- 3. Students found violating the BHS Code of Conduct by possessing, using, or found to be under the influence of alcohol/drugs and/or possessing or using a vaping device during any school event will be subject to disciplinary action by Brighton High School, and you will be notified to pick up your child.**
 - The possession of any drugs/alcohol may also result in a call to the police.
 - Students will be suspended from school and all activities, which may include future activities like dances, club activities, athletic competitions, etc.
 - Students will be instructed to take part in a drug/alcohol educational component with our school prevention/intervention specialist.
- 4. Communicate your expectations in regards to behavior during pre and post Homecoming activities. Know where your student will be and whom your student will be with during all events.**
- 5. Reinforce not using alcohol/drugs and what to do if an uncomfortable situation arises.**
