SUBJECT: Request for Transportation to Non-Public Schools for the 2020-21 School Year

The New York State Education Department (NYSED) deadline to apply for transportation services to a non-public school program is April 1 for the following school year. NYSED mandates the renewal application and application deadline. Applications received after April 1 are subject to review for eligibility and may be denied. **The Request for Transportation to Non-Public Schools form must be completed and received by the Brighton Central School District Transportation Department no later than April 1, 2020.** Please use the address/fax number above for submission of forms.

A new application must be submitted each year to request transportation services for your child, and a separate form must be completed for each child. **It is extremely important to ensure that all contact information (email, phone, etc.) on this form is accurate and up to date as this will be used for future communications.**

If you are new to the school district, the Request for Transportation to Non-Public Schools form must be submitted within 30 days of establishing residence in the district. Students must be registered prior to requesting transportation services. To register your child, contact the Brighton Central School District's Central Registrar at 242-5200 x5580.

The student's legal residence must be located in the Brighton Central School District boundaries and within a 15-mile distance from the school of attendance. Requests for transportation to and from an address other than your home must be within the district boundaries.

Brighton Central School District furnishes transportation to all K-2 resident students living at least 1/8 of a mile from school; to all grades 3-5 resident students living at least 1/4 of a mile from school; and to all grades 6-12 resident students living at least 3/4 of a mile from school.
