ARTICLE 7

- RATIFICATION
- STATES HAD TO Agree to Accept the Constitution
- Requires 9/13 states to Ratify Constitution

ARTICLE 4

- Relationship Between Federal govt and STATES
- Also Relationship Among STATES
- SEC 1 = "Full Faith + Credit" clause
 - Every state recognize the laws + Court Decisions of other States
- SEC 2 = "Privileges + Immunities" clause
 - A State MAY NOT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST Citizens of other States IN FAVOR of its OWN Citizens
- SEC 3 = Congress Can admit New States to the Union

ARTICLE 6

- Supremacy Clause
- "SUPREME LAW of the Land"
- Federal Law WINS over STATE LAW
- STATE CONSTITUTIONS ARE SUBORDINATE to Federal Law

ARTICLE 5

THE AMENDMENTS

- MUST BE PROPOSED By 2/3 of Both Houses
- THEN Approved by 3/4 state legislatures or State Conventions

ANOTHER PATH

- NEVER USED
- 2/3 STATE Legislatures Call + propose Amendment
- THEN Ratified By 3/4 STATE Leg.
- Congress Has Proposed 33 Amend
- Overall Over 5,000 Proposed
