KUDOS TO THE BHS AP BIOLOGY CLASSES

On Friday, May 17th, AP Biology students planted additional stream-side vegetation along Buckland Creek, adjacent to the softball field. The plants were provided by the NY DEC "Trees for Tribs" (tributaries) program - as a "buffer in a bag". This was a box of shrubs and small trees suitable for re-vegetating along small streams, such as Buckland Creek.

This activity is consistent with Lorax Club and Town of Brighton urban forestry programs, all designed to reduce runoff into streams, reduce nutrient input into local water bodies, improve water quality, improve wildlife habitat, increase groundwater recharge, improve aesthetics, sequester atmospheric carbon (climate change mitigation), and reduce urban "heat island" effects through evapotranspiration. All this - and more - from a box of baby trees and shrubs!

"Environmental stewardship" is a key component of the science curriculum - biology and environmental science, at any rate - and it's a very forward-looking, hopeful activity. Students are engaged, and learn basic skills and principles associated with urban forestry. **AP BIOLOGY students, YOU MAKE BHS PROUD!**
