Genesee Valley Forensic League – Coaches' Excellence Award – Cole Kuczek

Brighton Speech and Debate finished the 2018-19 season in 2nd place. Fourteen students on the team qualified for NCFL States this year, and two students competed in Nationals. BHS Senior **Cole Kuczek** was honored with the Genesee Valley Forensic League's Coaches' Senior Excellence Award for the 2018-19 Speech and Debate season. Cole shares the award with McQuaid's Michael Pavone. The trophy will be shared between the two schools during the 2019-2020 season. Brighton Coaches Karen Flynn and Rae Smith nominated Cole based on his qualities of dedication, hard work, leadership, and merit over his four years of

participation on the team. Cole competed in both speech and debate events, and was instrumental in helping to grow the club by encouraging other students to participate.
