ANNUAL ELECTION AND BUDGET VOTE

May 21, 2019

MINUTES

The annual election for the election of members of the Board of Education, and for the vote on the budget, and for two (3) propositions was held in the Brighton High School, 1150 Winton Road South, in the District, on May 21, 2019. At 6:45 a.m. Thomas Adams, co-chairperson of the annual election, announced that the Board of Education appointed Kenneth Harbison and Judith Harbison as co-chief election inspectors and certain other District residents as inspectors of the election. The names of the inspectors will appear on a schedule that will be attached to and made a part of these minutes.

The chairperson then noted that the inspectors present inspected the voting machines and certified that the ballot labels were properly placed, that all of the counters were set at zero (000), and that the machines were in proper condition and order.

It was announced that, pursuant to Education Law § 2031-a, no person may do any electioneering within 100 feet of the polling place. The polls were then declared open at 7:00 a.m.

At 5:00 p.m. the District Clerk was in possession of 72 unopened absentee ballots.

At 9:00 p.m. the chairperson closed the polls and announced that all duly qualified residents present in the polling place who had not voted would be permitted to vote. The votes were then tallied by the chief election inspector and the inspectors then in attendance.

The public counters on the voting machines reflected 2910 voters. In addition, 68 absentee ballots; five write-ins and 0 paper ballots were counted. Therefore, the total number of voters was 2,983. The result of the vote was announced by the District Clerk:

- a. Budget Vote – 1617 “yes” votes and 1335 “no” votes: budget not approved because 60% approval was needed.
- b. Proposition #1 -- Capital Reserve Fund (General) Withdrawal – 2208 “yes” votes and 716 “no” votes: proposition not approved because 60% approval was needed.
- c. Proposition #2 -- Capital Reserve Fund (Technology) Withdrawal – 2191 “yes” votes and 738 “no” votes: proposition not approved because 60% approval was needed.

d. Election of Board Members:

1A (Andrea Costanza)	1599 votes
1B (Karen Hatch)	1601 votes
1C (Audrey Sowell)	956 votes
1D (Heather Coyne)	1031 votes

Therefore, Andrea Costanza and Karen Hatch were elected for a term of three years to begin on July 1, 2019 and end on June 30, 2022.

The following will be attached to and made a part of these minutes:

1. a signed copy of the notice of the annual budget vote and election;
2. affidavits of publication received from The Daily Record and the Brighton Pittsford Post evidencing that the notice was published;
3. nominating petitions filed by each candidate for election to the Board of Education;
4. candidate certification statements;
5. a certificate of the clerk of the District indicating the results of the drawing which determined the order of the respective candidates' names in the voting machines;
6. a list of the election inspectors;
7. a copy of the voting machine inserts as they appeared in the voting machines; and
8. certificates of inspectors of election prepared at the opening and closing of the polls.
