BUDGET RE-VOTE

June 18, 2019

MINUTES

The re-vote on the budget, and for two (2) propositions was held in the Brighton High School, 1150 Winton Road South, in the District, on June 18, 2019. At 7:00 a.m. Rosalie Argento, co-chairperson of the annual election, announced that the Board of Education appointed Kenneth Harbison and Elizabeth Alva as co-chief election inspectors and certain other District residents as inspectors of the election. The names of the inspectors will appear on a schedule that will be attached to and made a part of these minutes.

The chairperson then noted that the inspectors present inspected the voting machines and certified that the ballot labels were properly placed, that all of the counters were set at zero (000), and that the machines were in proper condition and order.

It was announced that, pursuant to Education Law § 2031-a, no person may do any electioneering within 100 feet of the polling place. The polls were then declared open at 7:00 a.m.

At 5:00 p.m. the District Clerk was in possession of 136 unopened absentee ballots.

At 9:00 p.m. the chairperson closed the polls and announced that all duly qualified residents present in the polling place who had not voted would be permitted to vote. The votes were then tallied by the chief election inspector and the inspectors then in attendance.

The public counters on the voting machines reflected 2,696 voters. In addition, 136 absentee ballots and zero (0) paper ballots were counted. Therefore, the total number of voters was 2,832. The result of the vote was announced by the District Clerk:

- a. Budget Vote – 2294 “yes” votes and 531 “no” votes: Budget approved
- b. Proposition #1 -- Capital Reserve Fund (General) Withdrawal – 2371 “yes” votes and 430 “no” votes: Proposition #1 approved
- c. Proposition #2 -- Capital Reserve Fund (Technology) Withdrawal – 2310 “yes” votes and 489 “no” votes: Proposition #2 approved

1. a signed copy of the notice of the Budget Re-Vote;

2. Affidavits of publication received from The Daily Record and the Rochester Business Journal evidencing that the notice was published;
3. A list of the election inspectors;
