The InComplete Works of Shakespeare: Some Comedy is a mash-up adaptation of three of Shakespeare's comedies to poke fun at the ridiculous nature of love. Our show begins with wars: one in the human world between the Athenians (Thesues) and Amazons (Hippolyta) and a second in the Mystical Realm of Nature between Fairy royalty-Oberon and Titania. The members of the fairy world of *Midsummer* become so amused by the Athenian lovers, whose antics disrupt their woods, that Oberon decides to set up some more entertainment to woo back Titania. He invites actors to present abbreviated versions of the love stories of *Much Ado* and *Twelfth Night*, thus winning back the love and admiration of his queen.

Brighton High School will be providing transportation for 11th and 12th grade students to the 2019 HBCU College Fair on Monday November 19th at the Riverside Convention Center. This is a great opportunity to learn more about specific colleges, the college admissions process, and future careers. **On-site admissions interviews will be available to 12th grade students.** Students may interview with up to three colleges and must present transcripts, SAT/ACT scores and letters of recommendation in order to be scheduled. If a senior is interested in an on-site interview, they must also complete the enclosed Blue Sheet to request transcripts & test scores along with the field trip registration form. BHS will then provide copies of transcripts, test scores & letters of recommendation to the student on the day of the trip. Permissions slips are available in the BHS Counseling Office and Registrar's Office. Permission Slips are due to the Registrar's office by November 1st. We hope that you will find this information helpful in navigating the post-secondary journey!
