#### Process and Plan



- We review, plan, prepare, "scrub"
  - We communicate
- Governor makes a proposal: we review
  - We ask for input
- We advocate, we plan, we review
  - We ask for more input
- We react, discuss and refine plans
  - We share and again ask for input
- The Assembly and Senate make their proposals. An agreement is reached.
  - We finalize a proposal for voters to consider


What best describes your connection to the district?
