First week of February

 Departmental recommendations are prepared by teachers in English, Foreign Language, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

 Teacher observations of student achievement, test performance, and estimates of student interest and motivation. Department Interest Surveys.

 Teachers will discuss recommendations with students individually where appropriate and record the recommendations on each student's Course Registration Form.

Month of February

- Students meet with counselors during seminars
 - review teacher recommendations
 - discuss options in each curricular area
 - review each student's course load
 - Review graduation requirements
 - finalize the Course Registration Form.

Mid-March

- Initial staffing considerations are reviewed
 - Courses with fewer than 10 students, 15 students, etc.

 Course selections are mailed home to parents for final review. Adjustments can be made to student requests by contacting the counseling department by April 11th.
