First week of February

- **Departmental recommendations are prepared by teachers in English, Foreign Language, Math, Science, and Social Studies.**
 - Teacher observations of student achievement, test performance, and estimates of student interest and motivation. **Department Interest Surveys.**
 - Teachers will discuss recommendations with students individually where appropriate and record the recommendations on each student's Course Registration Form.

Month of February

- Students meet with counselors during seminars
 - review teacher recommendations
 - discuss options in each curricular area
 - review each student's course load
 - Review graduation requirements
 - finalize the Course Registration Form.

Mid-March

- Initial staffing considerations are reviewed
 - Courses with fewer than 10 students, 15 students, etc.
- Course selections are mailed home to parents for final review. Adjustments can be made to student requests by contacting the counseling department by April 11th.
- Finalizing schedules and choices for courses is critical for staffing considerations
