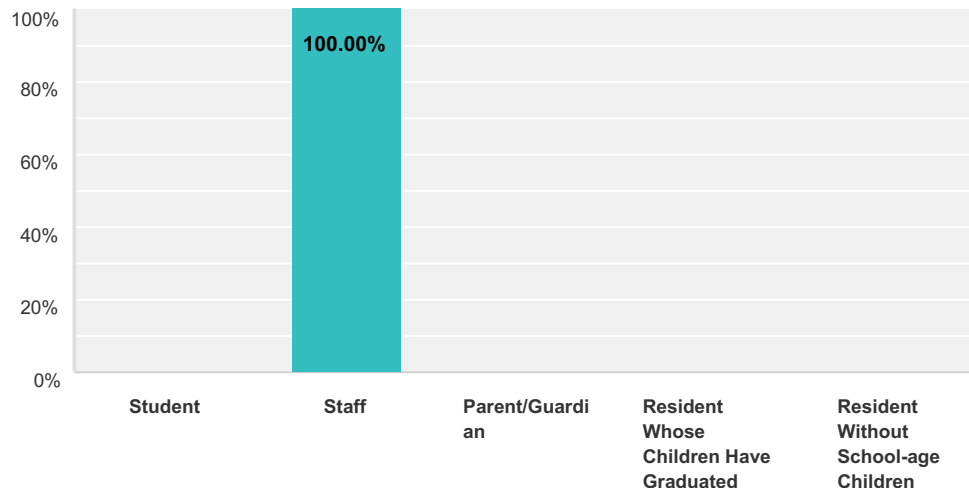

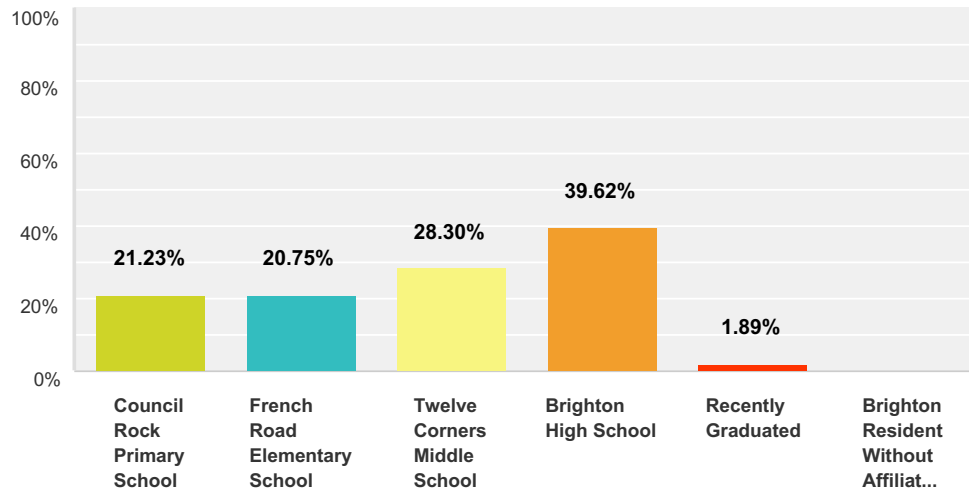

**Q2 What school community do you or your children represent? Please check all that apply.**

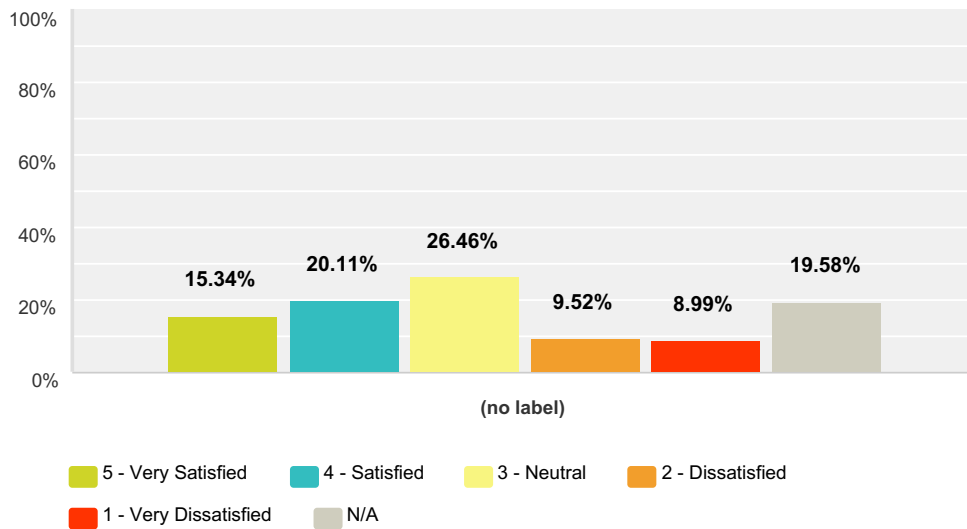

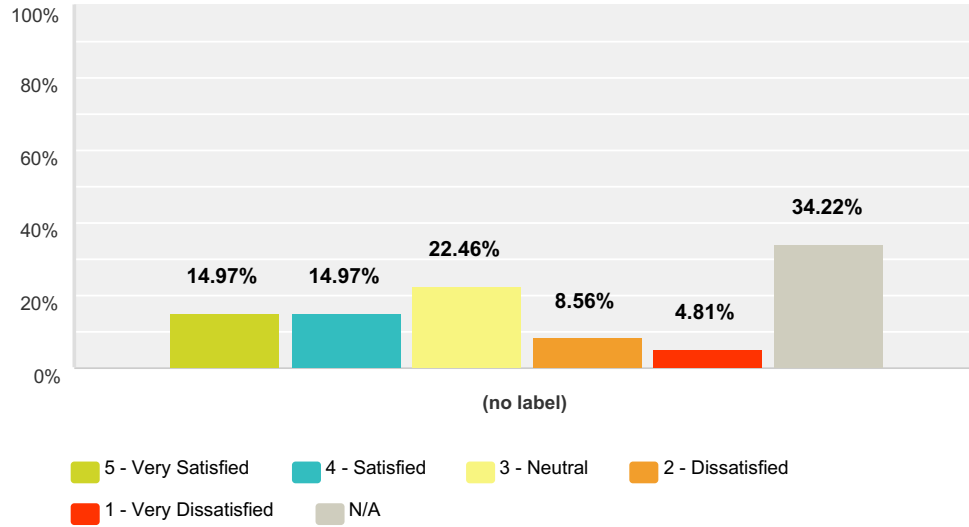

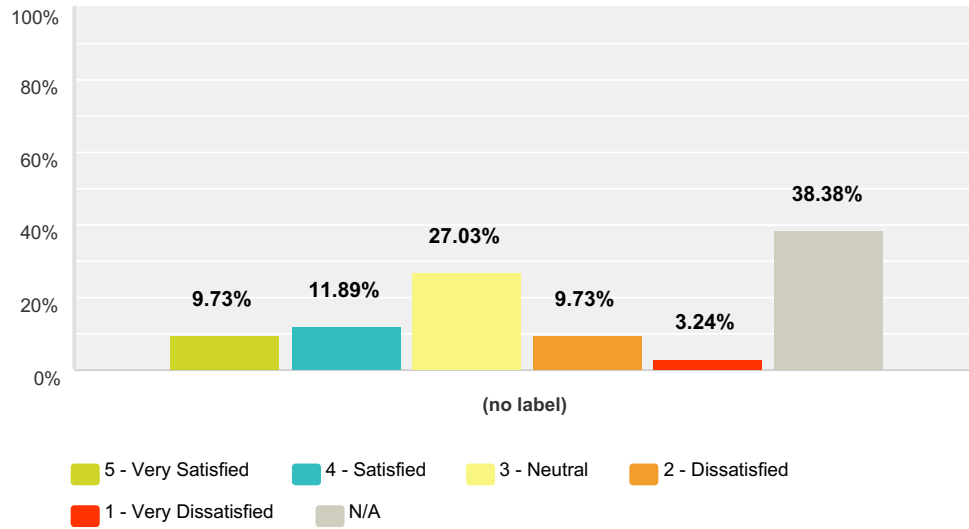

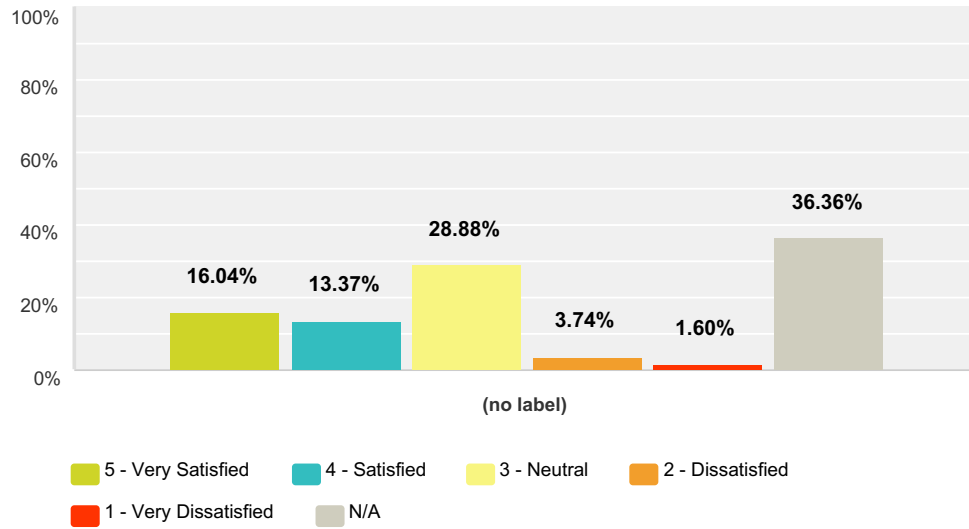

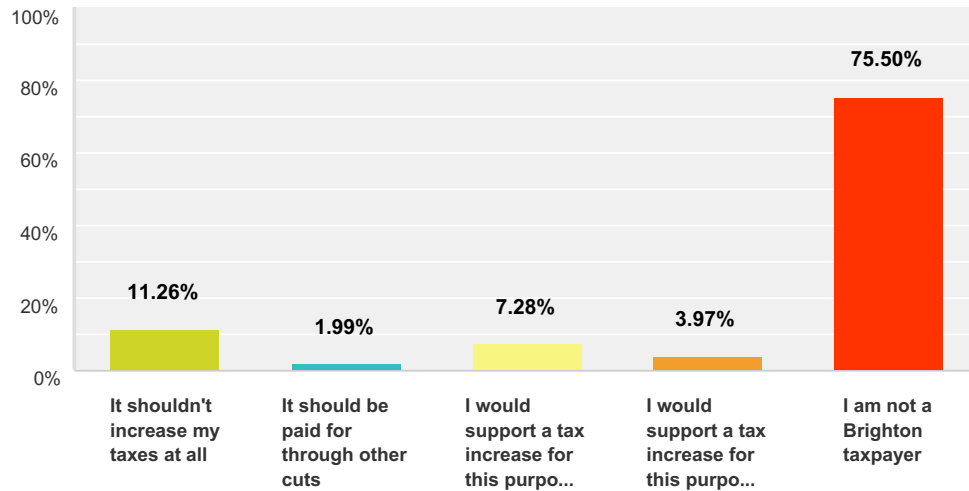
