Research the following topic:

Find information from at least two sources, and document these sources accurately. One of the two must be a print source (i.e., not a web site) from the resource room in the Media Center. The other must be a web site. Your summary of the information you found should be in paragraph form, including proper parenthetical citations. At the bottom of the page, include a Works Cited list.

Guidelines:

- Proper citation required
- Use paragraph form
- Do not use contractions or personal pronouns
- Information must be from at least two valid sources
 - To be sure an Internet source is valid, check for author's name and credentials, no misspelled words, and remember, scholarly work is analytical rather than opinionated.

Here is how your page should be formatted:
